

Pistol Range Rules

- No center-fire rifles (16.1” barrel or longer) permitted.
- No shotguns, slug guns, or muzzle-loaders permitted. We have other facilities available for this.
- No shotgun shells, shotgun slugs, pistol shot shells, or steel core bullets permitted.
- No full automatic weapons or bump shooting permitted.
- All center-fire ammunition fired from a pistol must not exceed 1500 fps. velocity.
- All rim fire rifles and pistols permitted and excluded from velocity restriction.
- Hearing and eye protection recommended to be worn at all times.
- Firearms must be pointed down range at all times
- The action of all firearms must be open when the shooter is not shooting
- Any given person will not be allowed to use a firearm if he/she appears to be under the influence of a drug, alcohol, or medication that may impair their judgment.
- No alcohol will be permitted in the shooting range.
- Any fowl language or offensive conduct is not permitted, shooters should take our younger sportsman into consideration.
- Aliquippa Bucktails is not responsible for any ricochet or personal harm.
- When multiple shooters are present, all shooters must shoot at the same yardage line.
- When going down range to check targets, all shooters must stop, unload their firearm and open the action until all shooters have returned to the bench.
- Only paper targets and balloons are suitable targets, all other targets are strictly prohibited.
- Range hours are 24 hours per day, 7 days a week EXCEPT, there is to be nobody shooting in the range when someone is present upstairs. Please check prior to shooting.
- All spent shells and targets must be removed prior to leaving.
- The rangemaster has the authority to eject anyone if the rules are not followed. Range Master is defined as any present board of director or officer.
