

Rifle Range Rules

- You must sign in (before using range) and out (after using range)
- Safety light “OFF” means no one is down range, safe to shoot. Make certain no one is down range before turning the lights off.
- Safety light “ON” means people down range. Completely unload firearms, open chamber, step away from benches.
- Absolutely no gun handling while lights are “ON”. This includes loading magazines, adjusting sights or scopes, swabbing muzzleloaders.
- Make sure everyone has “MADE SAFE” before going down range.
- All loading and unloading must be done from the benches with the firearm safely pointed down range.
- Firearm is to be pointed in a safe direction at all times.
- All shooting must be directed to impact inside target frames or inside bunkers.
- When shooting new loads, a new gun, or a new scope, start shooting at close range and work out to longer range.
- Absolutely no junk shooting, no cans, no rocks, no clay targets, etc.
- Eye and ear protection is highly recommended.
- No alcoholic beverages are permitted on the range.
- No armour piercing rounds are permitted.
- No fully automatic weapons are permitted.
- No 50 caliber BMG (or similar rifles permitted). 50 caliber muzzleloaders **are** permitted.
- Shooting shotgun pellets at the backstops is not permitted.
- No guests are permitted in November.
- Be courteous to other shooters around you.
