Pistol Range Rules

Firearms/Ammunition

- All ammunition must not exceed 1500 fps velocity.
- No center-fire rifles (16.1" barrel or longer) permitted.
- Pistol caliber carbines 9mm, 40 cal., 45 cal. are permitted.
- No shotguns, slug guns, or muzzleloaders permitted. We have other facilities available for these firearms.
- No shotgun shells, shotgun slugs, pistol shot shells, or steel core bullets permitted.
- No fully automatic weapons or bump shooting permitted.
- All rim fire rifles and pistols are permitted that meet above criteria.

Firearm Handling

- Loaded Firearms must be pointed down range or holstered at all times.
- The action of all firearms must be open when the shooter is not shooting.
- When multiple shooters are shooting, all shooters must shoot at the same yardage line.
- When going down range to check targets, all shooters must stop, unload their firearm, and open the action until all shooters have returned to the bench.
- Range hours are 24 hours per day, 7 days a week EXCEPT, there is to be nobody shooting in the range when someone is present upstairs unless it is during Clubsanctioned events.
- Only paper targets and balloons are suitable targets. All other targets are strictly prohibited.
- Targets may only be placed on the cardboard backing within the designated space. No targets may be placed below the "LOW LINE".

General Restrictions

- Any given person will not be allowed to use a firearm if he/she appears to be under the influence of a drug, alcohol, or medication that may impair their judgment.
- No alcoholic beverages/illegal drugs will be permitted in the shooting range.

- Offensive conduct is not permitted. Shooters should take our younger sportsman into consideration.
- Individuals under the age of 18 years must be under the direct supervision of a responsible adult at all times, and wear hearing/eye protection when at the firing line. Running, horseplay, climbing, etc. will not be tolerated.

Cleaning

- All spent shells, casings, and targets must be removed prior to leaving the range.
- Ensure that all lights and exhaust fans are OFF prior to leaving the range.
- Any present Officer or Director has the authority to eject anyone if the rules are not followed.
- Activities at this range are monitored via web cameras.

Range Guests

- Must sign in & complete all required paperwork prior to using the range. Required paperwork is located at the indoor pistol range podium.
- Sign out when finished using the range.
